

With the generous sponsorship from ACM SIGOPS, APSys'11 provides a limited number of travel grants to cover parts of travel and accommodation expenses for full-time students attending APSys'11 in Shanghai this year.

A full-time student who wishes to apply should submit an **up-to-date CV** describing the student's research background as well as a **one-page** position paper with the following information:

- **One to three paragraphs** explaining what benefit is expected from attending APSys'11 and arguing why the grant should be granted. The statement should describe any research the applicant has been doing and how it relates to systems and APSys. If you have an accepted paper or poster, **briefly** describe them in the position paper.
- **A financial statement** listing the possible expenses incurred to attend APSys'11 and detailing all other potential sources of travel funds and how much money the applicant applies (**in US \$**).

The selection committee will make a selection among applicants based on the submitted materials. Depending the distance to travel, the number of applicants, the geographic distribution of applicants, the selection committee will grant the applicants different amount of money (presumably no large than 500\$ and no less than 200\$).

Following the workshop, grants will be paid after travel receipts and a brief trip report have been received by with the Selection Committee. Note that, all applicants, whether being granted or not, still need to register the workshop and pay the registration fees.

The deadline for applications of student travel grant is ~~June, 23, 2011 (23:59, Beijing Time)~~ **extended to June, 26, 2011 (23:59, Beijing Time)**.

Notifications will be made by **June 27, 2011**.

Applications will also be accepted by electronic mail, and should in this case be addressed to both hbchen@fudan.edu.cn and zheng.zhang@microsoft.com. Each applicant will receive an email confirming that the application material has been accepted. If you don't receive an acknowledge email (in case of mails being dropped) after June 21, 2011, please contact any of the selection committees again.
